

HUNTERS GLEN BIBLE STUDY GROUP GOALS

1. Attempt to have 12 group - wide parties, activities or events and invite every member and every prospect to every fellowship every month.
2. Build your team: Enlist and fill all of your leadership positions. Enlist additional leaders in every position. This helps to identify and provide on the job training for potential leaders.
3. Give one Friday night to Jesus at least once a month. Host a game, movie, watermelon, ice cream, chicken foot, bowling, etc., night. This is for fun and fellowship to invite unchurched and non Christian friends. As folks begin to leave remind the regulars and invite the guests to Bible study. This could provide the opportunity to begin an in home week night Bible study.
4. Read at least one book this year on how you can be a better servant for the Lord. Begin reading "Making Small Groups Work" by Henry Cloud & John Townsend.
5. See at least 4 to 6 people reached through the ministry of your group by joining the group and /or the church in a year.
6. Pray and work toward having 2 guests each week in your group.
7. Follow-up with every new group member with a personal contact.
8. Set a goal to have a GROW Team from the group visiting members and prospects one Monday night a month. Know your groups grow night.
9. Pray and work toward baptizing 2 people into church membership through the ministry of your Bible study group.
10. Multiply your Bible study group in two years. Begin working now to multiply by August of 2018 or before.
11. Reach Unchurched Bible Study Group Members: In most churches 10% of Bible Study Group members are not members of a church. Let's cut this percentage through the demonstration of Christ's love, prayer, encouragement, fellowship, and visits.
