

Bible Study Teachers/Facilitators

Responsibilities

Group teachers/facilitators are responsible to the Minister of their age group. Responsibilities include guiding class members to grow spiritually through worship, discipleship, evangelism, missions and service/ministry. The teacher/facilitator is responsible for planning, conducting, and evaluating the work of the group in spiritual development and the application of God's word.

These responsibilities are carried out by:

Setting a positive example for others by living as an authentic follower of Jesus Christ and by being thoroughly involved in the life and ministry of Hunters Glen.

Leading the group in meaningful Bible study through the teaching and application of the Bible using creative methods to attract and hold attention of the group. Guiding each participant toward life change.

Building positive relationships with participants and prospects and ensuring that they are contacted regularly in order to meet needs and to minister to individuals.

Enlisting potential Teachers/Facilitators from within the group for the purpose of growing leaders. This will help facilitate the potential of multiplying a new class within two years from your group.

Contacting group members, especially absentees and guests.

Always teaching/facilitating evangelistically by sharing the "Gospel" through the Bible Study lesson. In addition, witnessing to lost members of the group and prospects.

Involving members in outreach activities.

Planning with the Group Leadership Team to set and achieve group goals.

Participating in training courses that are designed to strengthen the ministry.

Attending and participating in the Group Leadership Team planning meetings.
